



**11th Annual Campus Crime Stoppers
“Design the Poster” Contest
Rules and Prizes**

Poster Submission Deadline – April 5, 2023

The Campus Crime Stopper program operates under the umbrella of Midland Crime Stoppers and works closely with law enforcement to keep our students and campuses safe. Campus Crime Stoppers allows students to remain anonymous and/or confidential when they report criminal or illegal activity occurring on their campus without the fear of retaliation and pays cash rewards when information leads to an arrest or incident solved.

Contest Eligibility:

This Campus Crime Stoppers contest is open to all secondary students (7th-12th grade) currently enrolled and attending any Midland ISD, Greenwood ISD, or Midland Christian campus. Crime Stoppers of Midland, Inc. Board of Directors, volunteers and employees, and their immediate family members are not eligible to win.

REQUIREMENTS AND FORMAT:

1. Each poster must have the following:
 - a. **For Traditional/Freehand Posters** – Submit an original design using a variety of mediums such as paint, pen and ink, crayon, chalk, markers, charcoal, etc.
 - b. **For Digital Design Posters** – Submit an original design using any available design applications/programs and can submit posters in the form of graphic designs, digital illustrations, photographs, etc.
2. The design should promote the Campus Crime Stoppers program.
3. ***All posters must incorporate at least one of the following:***
 - Hotline number: **694-TIPS or 694-TIPS (8477)**
 - Website: **www.694tips.com**
 - Or Mobile app: **'P3 TIPS' in the poster.**

4. All posters must abide by the Student Code of Conduct and should not have any inappropriate/offensive language or designs, violence, etc.
5. All poster designs should fit on 11 inches wide by 17 inches long poster.
6. Illustrations must be used in addition to words.
7. *Art teachers, please recommend to the students that they refrain from putting any important information (ie: hotline, website, or mobile app), or images on the outer edges of the poster. If their poster is selected as the winner, we don't want it to be clipped off when printed.*
8. No copyrighted figures are to be used. Avoid Spongebob, Snoopy, the Simpsons, etc
9. No more than one entry per person
10. An entry form must be submitted with each poster.
11. All posters become the property of Crime Stoppers of Midland, Inc. –Campus Crime Stoppers
12. **Poster submission deadline is April 5, 2023**

Judging:

A panel of judges will determine the winning designs. The panel is made up of the Midland Crime Stoppers Board of Directors, the Executive Director, and a representative from MISD PD. The panel reserves the right to make minor adjustments to the design for the purposes of promotion and mass production. *The winner's lists will be emailed to the Principals and Art Teachers once judging is complete. The date of the prize presentation will be a day during the week of April 10-14th.*

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Visual impact, over-all appealing effect
- Effectively communicate the Campus Crime Stoppers message
- Campus Crime Stoppers relevance
- Neatness
- Original, Inventive and Creative
- Accuracy

Notification:

Once the winners have been selected, Crime Stoppers will notify the art teachers and the Principals of the names of the students whose posters have been selected for a prize. The date for the prize presentation will be announced at that time. Please be sure to provide the student's name, grade, campus, and the name of the art teacher on the entry form.

Legal Information:

By accepting any prize, the winner agrees to hold Campus Crime Stoppers and Crime Stoppers of Midland, Inc., its Directors, officers, and employees and assigns, harmless against all claims and liabilities arising from the use of the prize. The winner assumes all liability for any injury or damage that may be caused or claimed to be caused out of the use of the prize. The prize winner agrees to grant Midland Crime Stoppers Campus Crime Stoppers the right to use their name and photograph for promotional purposes without further compensation.
